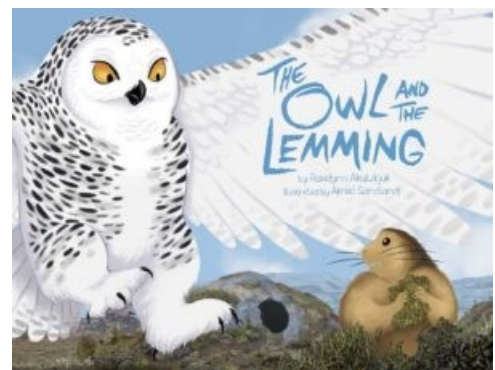
Up in the Air by Zoe Armstrong
