September 20, October 18, November 15, December 20, January 24, February 28, March 14, April 18, May 16, June 20. All meetings begin at noon.

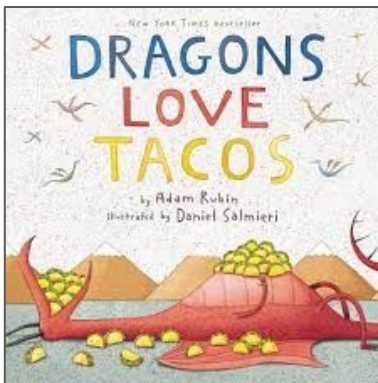
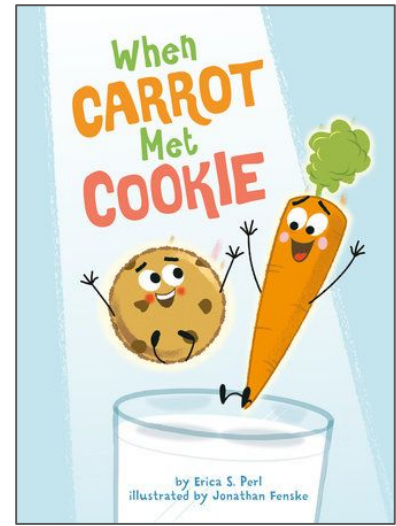
