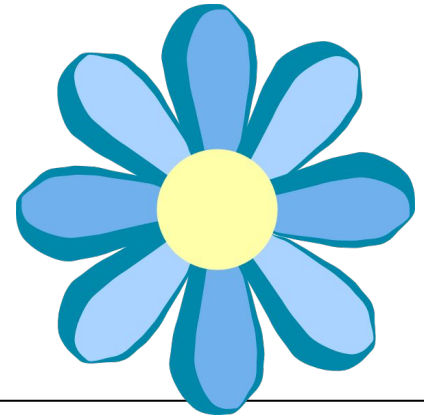

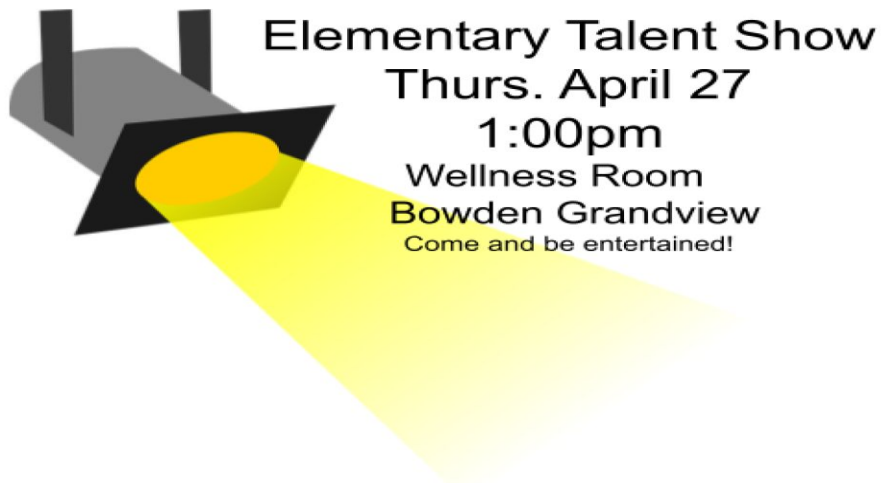

Make Someone SMILE on May 4th with a cookie from Tim Hortons.

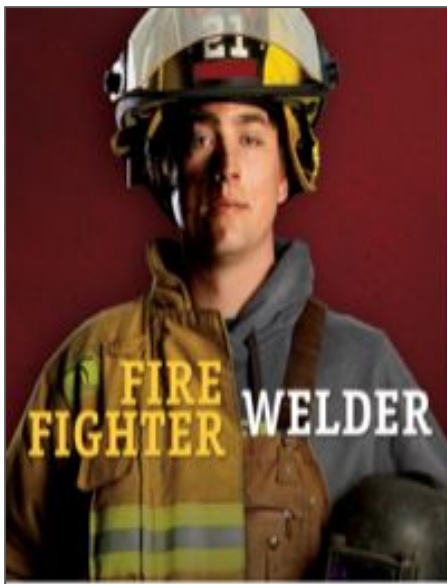
Pre-order your Smile Cookies today! Each cookie now costs \$1.50. Cookie sales start on Friday, April 28th, until Wednesday, May 3rd.

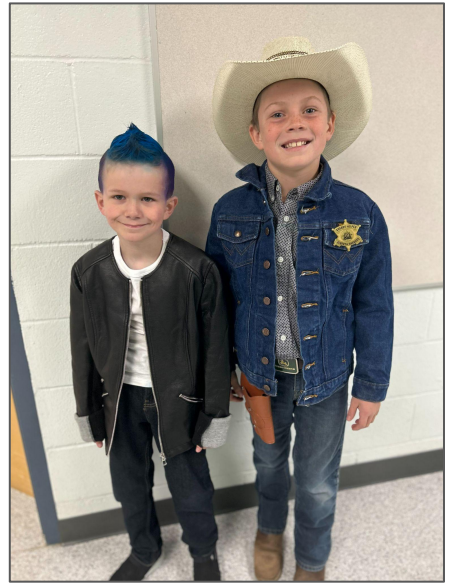

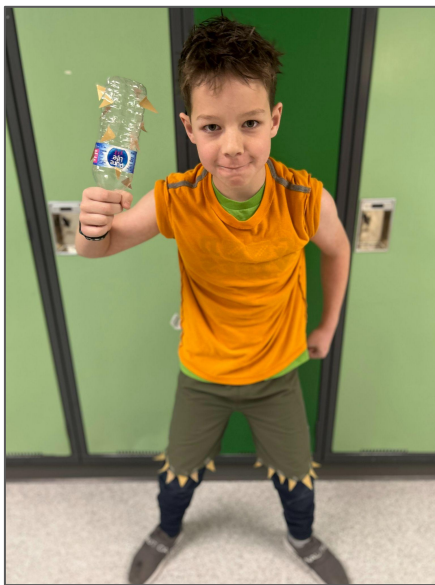

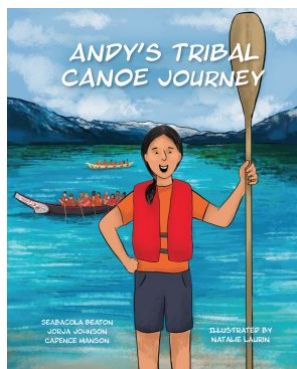


**The Big Umbrella** features a sweet metaphor using an umbrella to show inclusion and kindness. There is always room for everyone under this umbrella.
