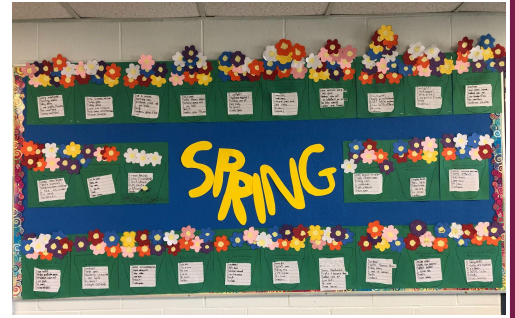

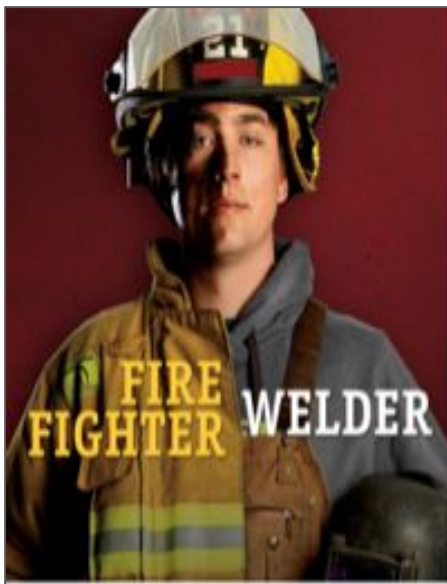


# Power Full Kids™

***The form contains a Walking field trip, Technology, Media and FOIP consents that has to be completed every year before your child can participate in these activities,***

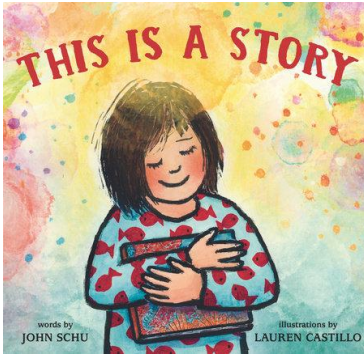

## Literacy

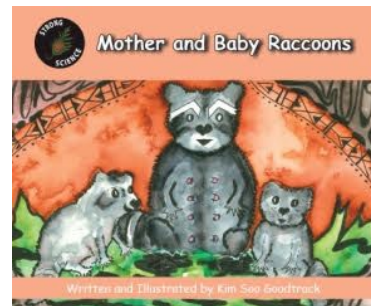
Why do we read? To slip into a fantasy? To find a connection? To gain new knowledge? We all read for different reasons and each book takes us on a journey.
