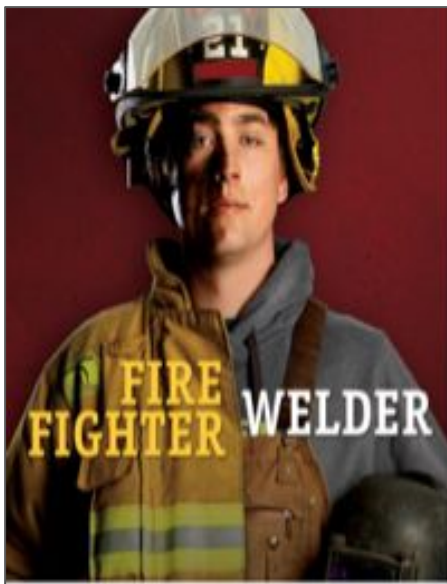
Bowden Grandview School Council 2022-2023
