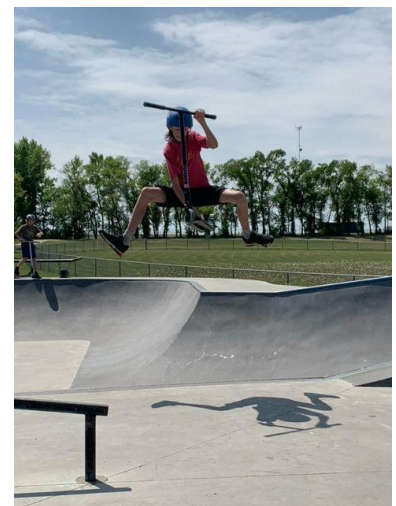
GRADE 9-12 JUNE 2023 - FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE

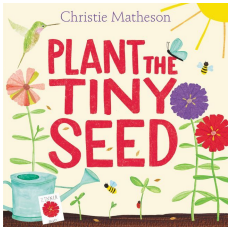

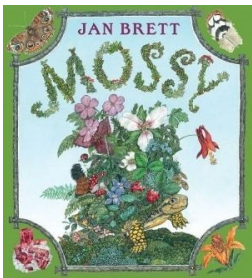


Plant the Tiny Seed by Christie Matheson
