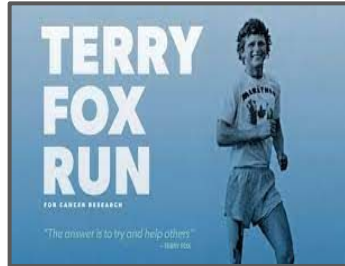

The Academic Awards Ceremony will be Friday, October 13th. Students being recognized will receive prior notice.

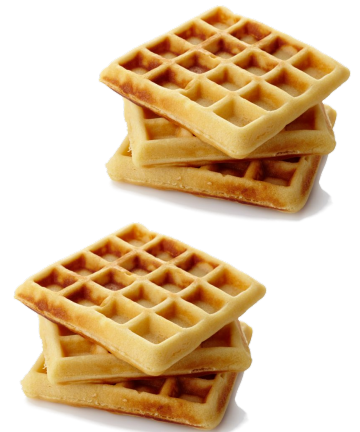
Bowden Grandview Cross Country Team
