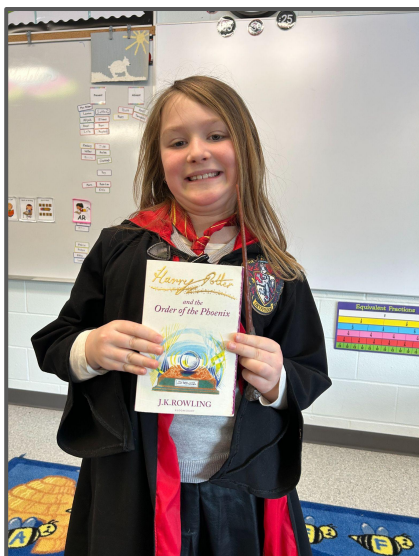
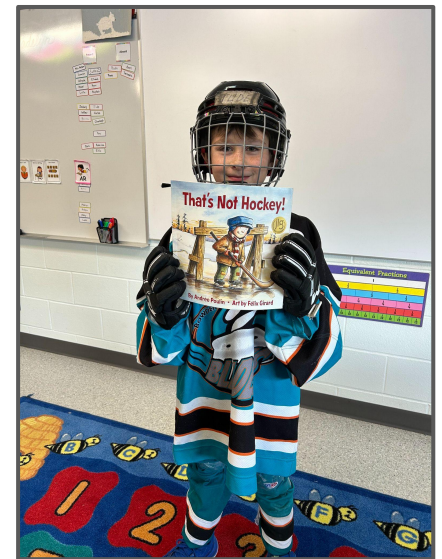
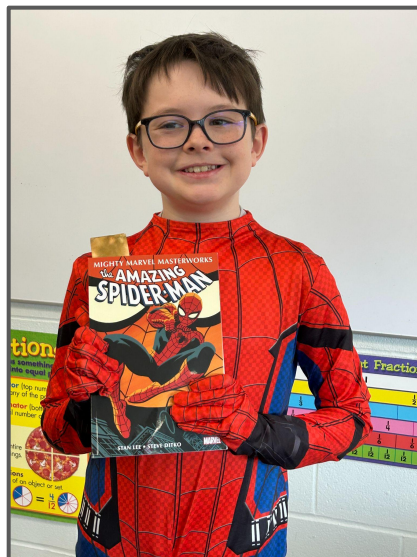
GRADE FIVE

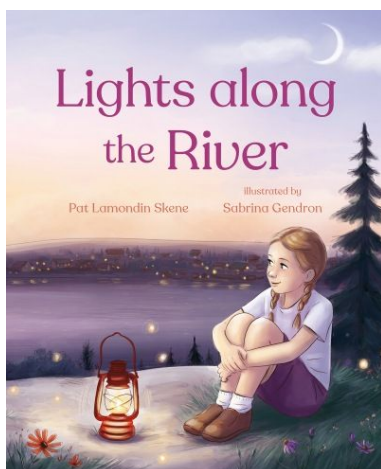
