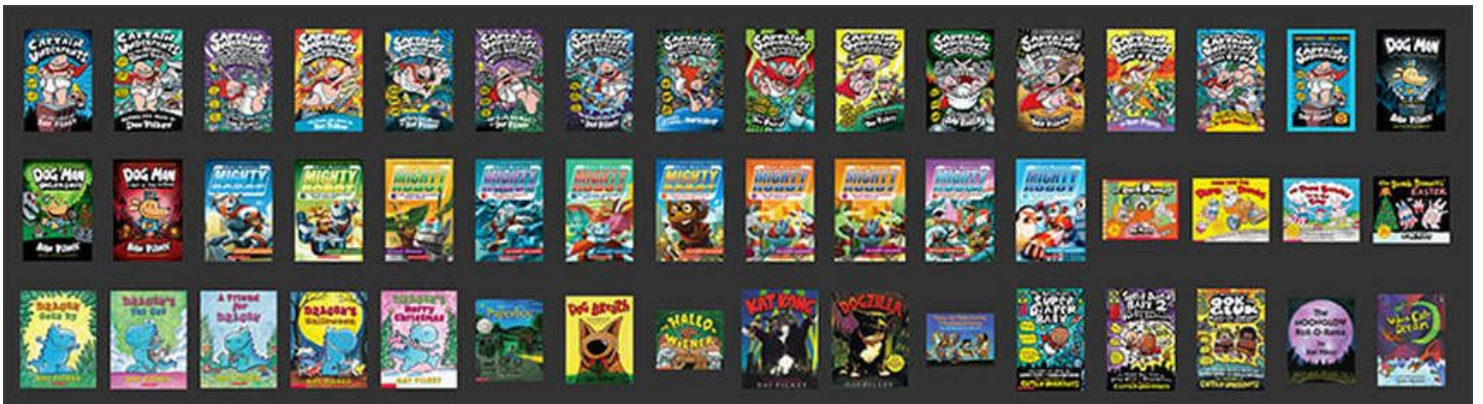

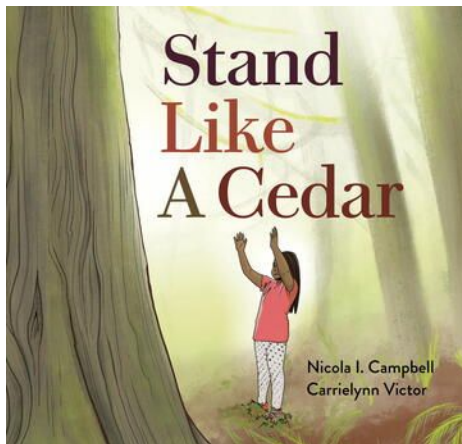
Literacy Corner

David "Dav" Pilkey (b. March 4, 1966), is a popular children's author and artist. Pilkey is best known as the author and illustrator of the Captain Underpants book series. In the early 1990s Pilkey wrote a series of books for beginning readers about a blue dragon. Titles in the series include *A Friend for Dragon* (1991) and *Dragon's Fat Cat* (1992). Pilkey's popular ***Captain Underpants*** series is aimed toward elementary- and middle-school students. The many books in the series follow the adventures of fourth graders George and Harold.

Pilkey's books have not only entertained children but have also had a positive impact on reluctant readers. With their accessible language, engaging illustrations, and relatable characters, his books have helped instill a love for reading in many young individuals who previously struggled with literacy.
